calendars, introducing acts, and greeting customers to setting up and putting away chairs after performances.

"We thought moving into a larger space (from across the street) would help, but we didn't plan on a recession," Wilkins says.

But she adds on an upbeat note that "while BWG is in the scariest stage economically, we are also experiencing the most rewarding stage, with people pitching in and proving that communal projects can work, and that creativity is a wonderful way of coping with hard economic times."
